Be sure to save the date for our annual **Sweetheart Banquet** on February 7<sup>th</sup> at 6 pm!


As we work to keep everyone safe during our gatherings, please help by directing children away from the kitchen area and encouraging them not to run inside the church.

**Spiritual Gift Surveys** are available in the foyer for anyone who would like to fill one out. Finished forms can go in the office mailbox.


#### Men & Women's Shelter of Lansdale - Volunteers Needed
