Bible-through-the-year study plans are located in the foyer.

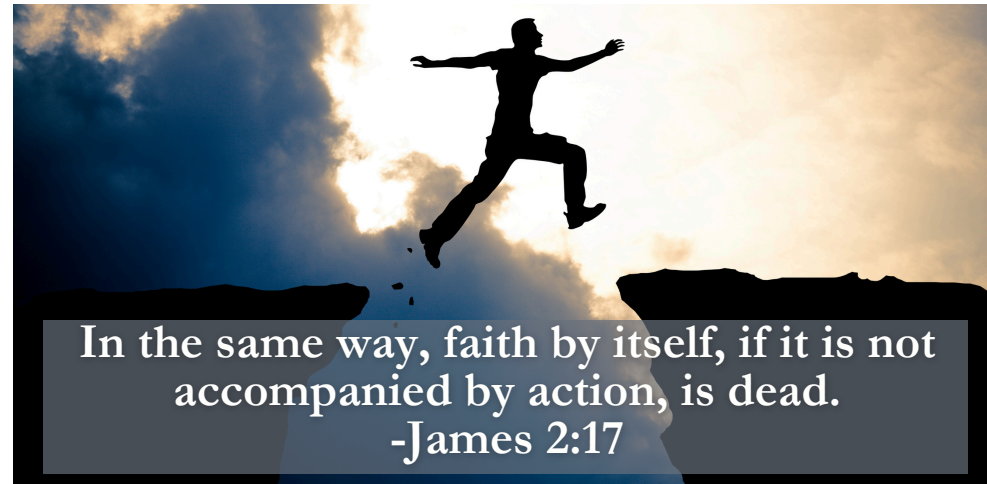
